Fellow Clevelanders,

Since taking office, I have remained committed to leading the City into a new age with a more prosperous and progressive future, using community-guided strategies to direct limited resources and ensure that they address neighborhood desires while taking into account changing market conditions. Our ultimate goal is to stop decline, stabilize neighborhoods, and build for the future.

Thrive 105-93 is an example of how, together, we can transform our streets to better serve people, reinvigorate commercial corridors, and attract new anchor institutions to neighborhoods long-plagued with disinvestment. The Thrive 105-93 Plan, completed in 2017 with robust public engagement, defined a collective vision for the neighborhoods connected by the #10 bus route along East 105th Street, Woodhill Road and East 93rd Street.

I am now asking for your continued involvement as we take the process one step further into the Preliminary Engineering Phase, setting the new course for the East 105th/Woodhill/East 93rd Corridor by identifying opportunities for investment and connecting those opportunities through quality, efficient, transit and multi-modal options. In addition, Thrive 105-93 supports the “15-minute city” framework proposed by my administration, aimed at attracting grocery stores, jobs, parks, and other necessities within a short walk, bike ride, or transit trip from residents’ homes.

This plan identifies ways in which communities along bus route #10 can work together to attract new investment and foster a renewed spirit of entrepreneurship all while emphasizing their neighborhood's unique citizens, attributes, and history.
